meeting, following issues were discussed, leading to actions being taken by the concerned departments:

	Issues Discussed	Action Taken
1	A matter of collaboration of ESIC MC&H, Faridabad and Rotary club is discussed.	The matter of collaboration between ESIC MC&H, Faridabad and the Rotary Club was discussed. It was noted that ESIC MC&H has a fully functional NABH-accredited Blood Bank. In case of emergencies, if blood is not available in ESIC because of any reason then it may be obtained from other centers those fullfilling the standard requirement.
2	Department wise mapping of drugs by pharmacists on the Dhanwantri Portal & data entry operators to be trained on calculating dosages based on doctor's prescriptions.	Pharmacists are mapping drugs department-wise on the Dhanwantri Portal. Dr. Shipra (Nodal Officer, Pharmacy) is providing updated drug lists to HODs to prevent prescription errors. Regular training is being conducted for data entry operators and pharmacists to ensure accurate dosage calculation based on doctors' prescriptions.
3	Issue of referring non-emergency and emergency patient to empanlled or Governement hospitals.	It has been decided that emergency patients are to be sent to empanelled hospital incase of non availability of inhouse beds and in case of non-emergency wherein elective surgery or procedure can take time, that may be reffered to Government hospital & if the government hospital does not have beds or provide late dates then patient may be reffered to empanelled hospital.
4	Irregularities in transferring samples from the wards and the sample collection room.	A direction has been issued that nursing incharge of concerned ward is responsible for timely sending of sample and reciept of reports & a register is to be maintained for entring the time of sample taken and reports handover to calculate turn around time.
5	Due to server issues distribution of medicine got delayed.	The complaints regarding server issues has been acknowledge by the HQ and waiting for the response. Dean sir asked to external members for representing this issue to the headquarter for a solution.
6	Issue regarding stamp and sign or putting name of Drs on prescription is discussed.	A direction has been issued regarding doctor stamp on prescription, incase the stamp is not available, the name & designation is to be mentioned in bold letter.
