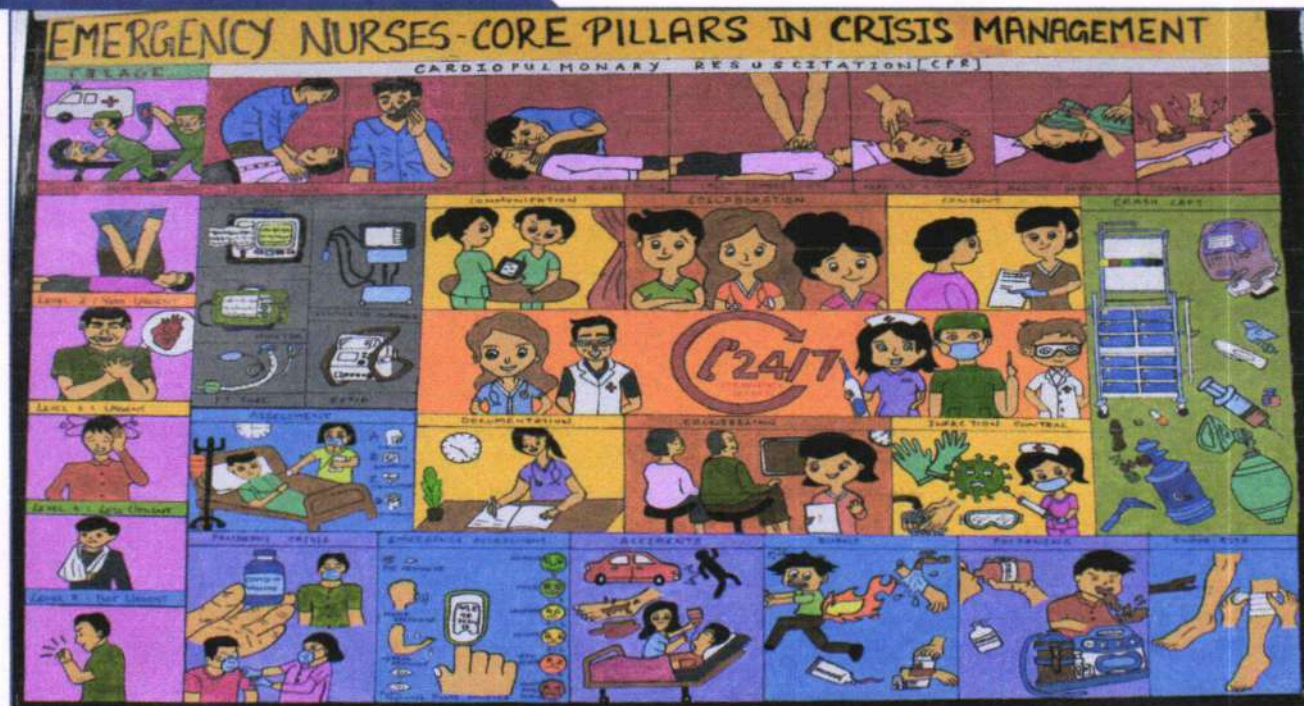
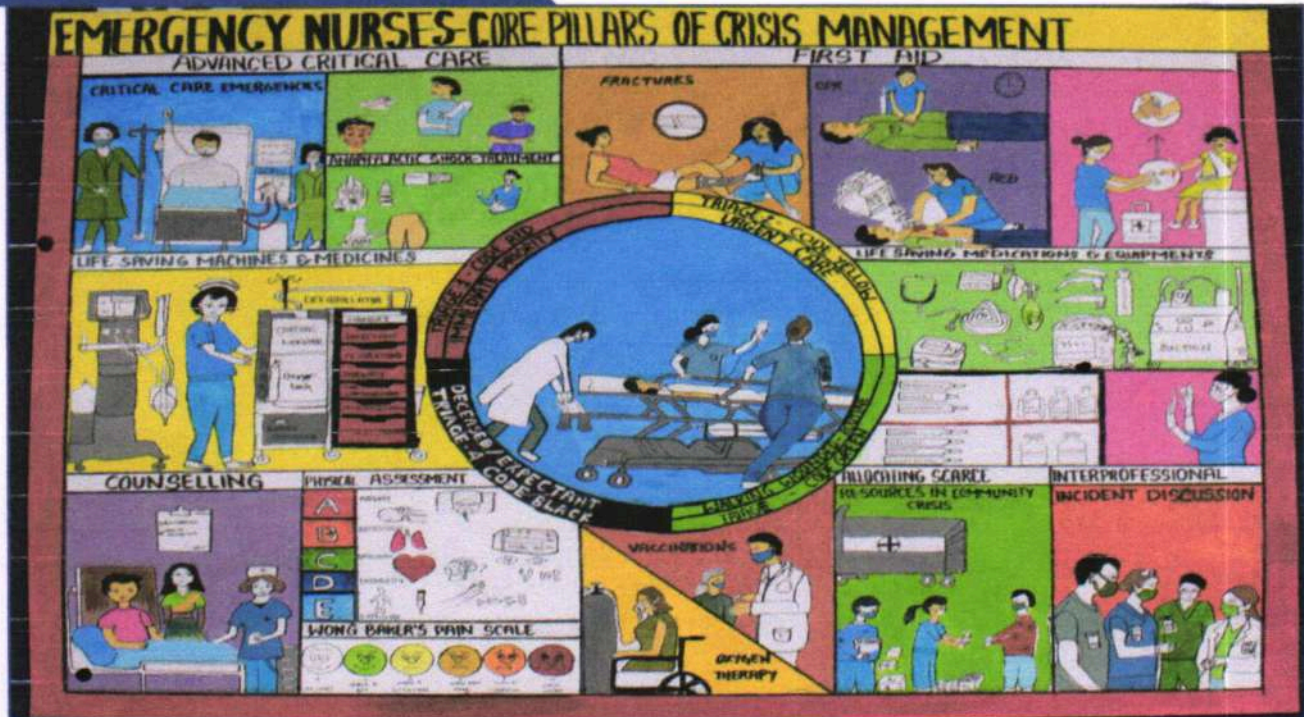
Prize Distribution
